

## 2009 Council Camporee Centennial Kick-off

Grissom Aeroplex near Peru May 1-3, 2009

Fee \$10.00 per person (\$13.00 after April 24,2009)

The 2009 Council Camporee is a great opportunity to kick-off the Centennial Anniversary of Boy Scouting in America with fellow Scouts and Scouters from different parts of the Sagamore Council. Your Scouts will have an opportunity to participate in challenging activities.

**Location:** Grissom is located on the west side of Hwy 31 between Kokomo and Peru. Turn west on Hoosier Blvd. Turn right onto Constellation. Registration is in the parking lot at the corner of Constellation and Lightning Ave. Follow the signs and they will lead you to the site.

**Program:** The program will include activities for three age groups. First year Scouts will participate in skill and rank related activities. The intermediate Scouts will have challenging Scout skill related activities. Older Scouts over 15 years of age and Venturers will have an off site adventure. Newer and intermediate Scouts will go through the Air Museum as part of their program.

**Museum:** Visits to the Grissom Air Museum will be scheduled, by patrol, throughout the day. The Scouts will be lead through the museum by their staff so group sizes are limited to 25 per session. A gift shop is available at the museum.

**Camping:** Camping will be on a 21 acre section of the old base where building have been torn down and grass planted in a park like setting. Each Troop will be given an area to set up their campsite. Space may be limited so encourage your Scouts to share tents. Portable toilets will be spread throughout the camping area.

**Meals:** Each Troop is to supply their oven food and cooking equipment. Oven fires are not allowed. Off the ground charcoal bar-b-ques or propane stoves are recommended. This is a leave no trace campout, so what you bring in you must take out. Please bring the water you will need for cooking and drinking. Lunch for the older Scouts and Venturers participating in the off site program will be provided

**Campfire:** Saturday night each Troop will be asked to present a Song and/or a skit for the closing campfire. The highlight of the evening will be the Order of the Arrow Call out ceremony.

**Leaders Golf Tournament:** Scout leaders and parents will be able to participate in a Pro-Am 9 hole golf tournament (the professional staff are the "pro" and the Scout leaders are the "Am"). There is a \$18.00 fee for the tournament. The fee includes green fees and a cart. The tournament is limited to the first 30 participants signed up at the Scout Office. Registration for the Tournament must be made prior to April 24, 2009.
